Getting Started

1. Your login information for Genius SIS is the same as it was for Maestro SIS. You can bookmark the new URL www.edmentum.com/sislogin
2. If you do not remember your login credentials, simply click on the login/password retrieval link under the Sign me in button. Enter your login or email and a message will be sent to the email account associated with your login. **Note:** Check junk mail/spam folder if you do not see the email in your inbox.
3. Throughout the week, you may also check your email for further information regarding course enrollment and teacher communication.

Genius SIS/Launching Courses

 - Once logged in, find the course to start working on first.
